1. Data processing

- We use the data you provided on this form to assess your application and, once membership has been granted, for the purposes of membership administration and support within the AWO and, where applicable, the AWO Youth Organisation.
- The legal basis for data processing is the membership contract between you and the AWO and, where applicable, the AWO Youth Organisation, in accordance with Article 6(1)(b) of the EU GDPR. The legal basis for storing your data in accordance with commercial and tax law provisions is Article 6(1)(c) of the EU GDPR.
- The provision of this data is necessary for membership of the AWO and, where applicable, the AWO Youth Organisation. If the data requested is not provided, the membership application cannot be processed.
- In processing your data, we engage service providers who act respectively within the framework of data processing on behalf of the controller in accordance with Article 28 of the EU GDPR.
- Upon becoming a member, your data will be forwarded by us to the AWO Bundesverband e.V. (Central Membership and Address Administration), to the relevant AWO regional, district, sub-district, county and municipal or city organisation and local association in your region, and, where applicable, to the relevant chapter of the AWO Youth Organisation. To determine which chapters are responsible for

your membership, the details provided in your membership application may be forwarded to the state, district, sub-district, or county organisation responsible for your place of residence. Any data forwarded outside the remit of your local chapter will be deleted no later than one year after collection or transfer.

- f. All personal data collected in connection with your membership will be deleted upon termination of membership unless we are legally entitled or obliged to continue processing your data. Data relevant to accounting purposes will be deleted ten calendar years after the end of membership.

2. General information and rights of data subjects

- a. You have the right to request information from us regarding the data we hold about you.
- b. If your personal data is inaccurate or incomplete, you have the right to have it rectified and supplemented.
- c. Provided the legal requirements are met, you may request a restriction on the processing of your personal data or object to the processing entirely.
- d. You may request the erasure of your data at any time, provided we are not legally obliged to continue processing your data. In any case, the erasure of your data requires the termination of your membership in accordance with the provisions of the applicable Articles of Association.
- e. You have the right to data portability regarding the data you have provided, provided this does not infringe upon the rights and freedoms of others.
- f. If you believe that the processing of your data violates applicable law, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a competent supervisory authority (e.g. the State Data Protection Commissioner).
